**Little Finger** – I need to \_\_\_\_\_ God’s Word

**James 1:18-19** (NIV) <sup>18</sup> He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created. <sup>19</sup> ...Everyone should be quick to listen...

**Romans 10:17** (NIV) Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

**Ring Finger** – I need to \_\_\_\_\_ God’s Word

**Revelation 1:3** (NCV) Happy is the one who reads the words of God’s message, and happy are the people who hear this message and do what is written in it.

**1 John 1:1,4** (NCV) <sup>1</sup> We write to you about the Word that gives life. <sup>4</sup> We write this to you so you can be full of joy with us.

**Deuteronomy 17:19** (NLT) He must always keep this copy of the law with him and read it daily as long as he lives.

**Acts 17:11** (NIV) ...They received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

**Romans 15:4** (NIV) For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

**Proverbs 7:2-3** (NLT) <sup>2</sup> Guard my teachings as your most precious possession. <sup>3</sup> Tie them on your fingers as a reminder. Write them deep within your heart.

**Psalms 119:11** (NIV) I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

**Thumb** – I need to \_\_\_\_\_ God’s Word

**Psalms 1:2-3** (NCV) <sup>2</sup> They love the LORD’s teachings, and they think about those teachings day and night. <sup>3</sup> They are strong, like a tree planted by a river. The tree produces fruit in season, and its leaves don’t die. Everything they do will succeed.

**Joshua 1:8** (NIV) Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

**James 1:22-24** (NCV) <sup>22</sup> Do what God’s teaching says; when you only listen and do nothing, you are fooling yourselves. <sup>23</sup> Those who hear God’s teaching and do nothing are like people who look at themselves in a mirror. <sup>24</sup> They see their faces and then go away and quickly forget what they looked like.
